

This entry level tutorial helps to understand the required steps to create and validate XBRL instance documents, and its relation with the <a href="Data Point Model">Data Point Model</a> (DPM). Herm Fischer and the BR-AG tutoring small groups with hands on <a href="Open Source">Open Source</a> tools and proof of concept examples, to be further reproduced at home (laptop with <a href="Aerelle">Aerelle</a> recommended).
