Key challenges

- The implementation of COREP creates challenges across all layers of the organisation, with particular impact on finance and risk. Key challenges are:
 - implementation timelines
 - regulatory interpretation
 - increased complexity
 - systems to consolidate and report data
 - risk and finance operating models
 - data availability and governance
 - controls and sign off
 - increased external disclosure.

Which of these challenges turned out to be the most critical? How can we help address them for the future?


Highlights from the past

- agreed operating model including responsibilities for data accuracy, review and sign-off.


