## **NEW FINREP TAXONOMY**

A new FINREP Taxonomy was published on 31st December 2009.

This XBRL taxonomy, like all major XBRL taxonomies, represents a significant effort by a large number of people, in this case by people primarily within the FINREP XBRL group.

Request for Comments.

What is being requested now, via this communication, is the expert opinion, comments and observations of all the relevant parties that will interact with this new Taxonomy.

This taxonomy reflects the extensive learning that has occurred since the release of the first FINREP taxonomy in 2006, with particular emphasis on simplifying the data mapping of the taxonomy back to existing databases. This has been achieved by a comprehensive analysis of the detailed reporting requirements of the FINREP Templates, coupled with a clear focus on understanding exactly what is required by each data point in the templates.
